The Sons of Norway Foundation Board of Governors is seeking talented Sons of Norway members who wish to join in the governance of this well-respected, fifty-one-year-old organization. Skills that are desired include strategic planning and operations, social media influencing, development and fund raising and/or finance and accounting. The board is comprised of 10 voting members and four non-voting members from across the United States who are volunteers who serve without pay. A governor may serve up to three consecutive two-year terms.

The board supports the work of the Sons of Norway Foundation and provides mission-based leadership and strategic governance. While day-to-day operations are led by the Foundation director who reports

to the Sons of Norway's chief executive officer, the board-staff relationship is a partnership, and the appropriate involvement of the board is both critical and expected.

Duties include, but are not limited to:
Working with the director and other board members to ensure that board resolutions are implemented;
Approving the Foundation's annual budget, audit reports, business decisions, as well as helping manage nearly \$8 million in assets;
Serving on committees or task forces by accepting special assignments;
Representing the Foundation to stakeholders, and acting as an ambassador for the organization; and
Prioritizing personal giving by making an annual gift, reflecting the Foundation's priority.

The Foundation is dedicated to funding activities that preserve and promote Norwegian heritage, positively affect members, and make Sons of Norway communities more vibrant places to live. The application deadline is Sept. 10, 2018.

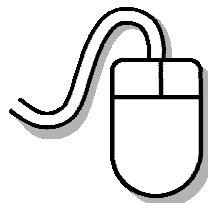

Edvard Grieg Society Jazz on Tues. Oct. 2, 2018



The Edvard Grieg Society has lined up Norwegian Jazz artist Tord Gustavsen and trio to perform during the **Leif Eriksson International Festival**.

Details will come in the September issue of the Communicator. Please plan to attend this special evening concert! (7:30 p.m.)

This concert marks not only Tord Gustavsen's return to Mindekirken, but also his return to the piano trio setting that brought him to worldwide attention with the release of *Changing Places* in 2003. His newest and eighth album for ECM, *The Other Side*, will be re-released in August 2018 and expands his piano trio repertoire with new compositions as well as arrangements of J.S. Bach chorales and traditional Scandinavian hymns. Joining him are bassist Sigurd Hole and his long-standing collaborator, drummer Jarle Vespestad.



The elements of Gustavsen's work remain intact – a paradoxical blend of simplicity, quietude, and sensuality built on the hymns of his youth, a Nordic kind of blues, and an instinct for composition. With the passage of a decade of creativity, he has come full circle to the piano trio but with a new perspective that, as ever, moves his music forward.

Tickets are \$25 at the door or in advance. A reception and meet-and-greet at Norway House will follow the concert.
